

## BOOK ADVENTURES PROGRAM:

This is a school-wide program using the website [www.bookadventures.org](http://www.bookadventures.org).

Book lists are available which include a variety of genres and titles from which the students may choose. These lists are displayed in the classrooms, in our school library, and at the Parma-Snow Library. In addition, Mrs. Schulte has highlighted the titles we have in our collection and pulls them out for easy access. It is the student's responsibility to get the book.

TESTS will be given during the regularly scheduled Computer classes on Thursdays and Fridays. The dates for the 2009-2010 school year are as follows for grades 2-8:

October 29/30  
November 19/20  
January 28/29  
February 25/26  
March 25/26  
April 29/30  
May 20/21

Grade 1 will begin Book Adventures in January 2010—same dates for the remainder of the year.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The students will receive a grade for Book Adventures in both Reading and Computer. The scores will be made available to teachers once the students have taken their tests. **Failure to complete the reading of the book and/or doing poorly on the test can have a serious negative impact on the child's grade in these two subjects.** The students may read more than one book and receive extra credit for Computer class. Extra credit may be given in Reading at the discretion of each reading teacher.

Students may go to the Book Adventure website to take ONE practice test at home. They may only take a test on the book they have read TWICE. If the student tries to take two practice tests at home, they cannot re-take it at school and will receive a zero. The tests are different each time and for each computer.
